You will be amazed by how much you can grow and achieve in just one year. To start our year off on a strong note, I require each incoming freshman to complete a summer reading assignment. The summer reading assignment is meant for you to continue to expand your interest in reading and discover what types of books you actually enjoy reading. All I ask of you is that you do your best, keep a positive outlook, and have an open mind.

Below you will find the novel options you are to choose from and the writing assignment that will accompany your reading. **Your summer reading assignment is due at the beginning of class, typed and printed, by Friday, September 14th.** Please see below for more information:

Choose **TWO** of the following novels to read:

1. Little Women by Louisa May Alcott
2. Every Soul a Star by Wendy Mass
3. Holes by Louis Sachar
4. The Absolutely True Diary of a Part Time Indian by Sherman Alexie
5. Stargirl by Jerry Spinelli
6. Season of Life: A Football Star, A Boy, A Journey to Manhood by Jeffrey Marx

Then, write a five paragraph essay according to the following format:

- 1. Paragraph one- Opening:**
 - a. Tell the audience what two books your read.
 - b. Explain why you chose each book.
 - c. Give your personal opinion on book one-what you liked, what you didn't like.
 - d. Give your personal opinion on book two-what you liked, what you didn't like.
- 2. Paragraph two- Book One:**
 - a. Summarize book one. What were the key details? What was the main idea?
 - b. Describe the character in the first book you read. What three characteristics would you use to describe that person? Explain why.
 - c. What problem/challenges is the character faced with?
 - d. How do you relate to the character? Are you similar or different to them? Explain how.

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3. Paragraph three- Book Two:

- a. Summarize book two. What were the key details? What was the main idea?
- b. Describe the character in the second book you read. What three characteristics would you use to describe that person? Explain why.
- c. What problem/challenges is the character faced with?
- d. How do you relate to the character? Are you similar or different to them? Explain how.

4. Paragraph four- Compare/Contrast:

- a. How are the main characters in BOTH your books similar? For example- Do they deal with similar challenges? Do they react in the same way to problems? Do they live similar lives?
- b. How are the main characters in BOTH your novels different? Which character do you find more relatable?

5. Paragraph five- Conclusion

- a. Restate what two novels you read.
- b. Explain if you were happy or not with your choice. If not, what would you have preferred to read?
- c. Would you recommend these books to someone else?
