FACTS BILLING / PAYMENTS

The last tuition payment is due on 4/15. Please continue to make regular payments on your account. Payments can be made: Automatically to FACTS; online through your FACTS account; by calling FACTS at 1-866-441-4637; or by mail to FACTS at P.O. Box 2597 Omaha, NE 68103-2597.

21/22 SCHOOL YEAR

Facts has rolled over the information from last year. You can go in to your account to make any changes, or to add Peace of Mind insurance. Please review your contact information and method of payment. Please note - families who sign up for Auto Pay, and have all on time payments throughout the year, receive a \$120 refund at the end of the year.

REGISTRATION FEE

The re-registration fee has been added to the 9th, 10th and 11th grade accounts. The fee is \$200, it is due by the final billing period.

SPRING SPORTS FEES

I have added the Athletic fees for Baseball to the next bill. Tuition should be current in order for this fee to be paid.

DELINQUENCY

Tuition accounts must be kept up to date. **STUDENTS CANNOT HAVE BALANCES OVER 90 DAYS PAST DUE. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RETURN TO SCHOOL IF THE ACCOUNT GOES OVER 90 DAYS - PLEASE RECTIFY YOUR BALANCE AND CONTACT TUITION TO AVOID THIS SITUATION.**

If you have an Emergency of some kind, or anything else that is preventing you from being current with your tuition, please send me an email to let me know what the situation is. There are limited funds available to help with unforeseen circumstances.

FACTS FINANCIAL AID

21/22 - Please complete the FACTS Aid application right away - the deadline has been extended from 12/31. Aid is given out first come first served. You can go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> to complete the application. Note - students who receive any School Academic, Millay, Maguire, Howley, Leadership or financial aid, must complete this application to qualify again in 21/22. You will need to upload a copy of your 2019 or 2020 tax return to the application.

20/21 - The application is closed. If you already submitted the application, you can still attach any necessary documents to the application to bring it to completion.
